Registration, Explanations & Notes!

Registration for Classes:

Sign up at door 1/2 hour before class on 1st night of class, classes close after 2nd meeting! On 2nd class or thereafter pick up a repeat pass for repeatable classes. **Bring your repeat pass every class hour you are repeating.**

Fees/Explanations:

Level Classes have numbers following the name of the class, can be repeated for free with repeat pass, if space is available. Levels 1-4 = Beginning levels, Levels 5-8 = Intermediate, Levels 9+ = Advanced. The same patterns are repeated each time the course is taught.

4 - week classes: \$38/4 weeks or \$45/5 weeks* (bonus class).

6 - week classes: \$53/6 weeks or \$60/7 weeks* (bonus class).

Non Level Classes contain the words: Beginning, Intermediate or Advanced, (Beg., Int. or Adv.) and are not repeatable. New material is taught each new course. For example, if the course is Intermediate the student should be in or have completed a level 4 class in the topic. Includes some technique, individual instruction, and tricks/flashy moves. An a,b,c, etc. indicates how many sections (6 weeks) of the class have been taught.

6 - week classes : \$50/6 weeks or \$57/7* weeks (bonus class).

Courses must be paid in full even if classes are missed.

* **Bonus rate:** \$7/hour at registration or \$12 drop in at class.

Multiple Classes Discount: For discounts to apply, you must register and pay for all classes at the same time (*discount applies to one person taking different classes*).

2 courses \$2 off/ course, 3 courses = \$3 off/course, 4 courses = \$4 off/course 5 courses = \$5 off/course.

Discounts apply to full priced classes only. Classes taken at the coupon price do not count toward the discount. One night only class is \$12 per hour. For refunds, classes already held are subtracted at \$12 per class.

Pay by cash or check. We do not accept credit or debit cards.

Full-time Student Discount:

This is a discount to give financial assistance to full-time (12+ units) students (elementary, Jr. or Sr. High, or College/ University) pay half price for classes and dances with current student I.D (please show ID) and course schedule! Rounded up to the nearest dollar. (Does not apply to adults taking personal growth or vocational type monthly courses or continuing ed. e.g. National University or Phoenix, etc).

Floor Fees

\$15/hr/lesson for Independent instructors, \$12 DT instructors.

35% or \$25/ hour (the greater amount) : class downstairs *

35% or \$35/ hour (the greater amount): class upstairs *

*These class rates are for Dancetime teachers only.

** **Hip Hop For Dancers** (basics): Body movement to loosen up and add to your swing, Latin and freestyle dancing!

** **West Coast Swing** (basics & beyond): An introduction to West Coast basics & elements. Prerequisite: None

** **Lindy Hop** (Early Int.): Instruction in Lindy patterns & technique. Prerequisites: Lindy Hop basics.

** **West Coast Swing** (Cutting Edge style & footwork): Footwork variations & style for West Coast. Basics required.

** **Introduction to Swing** (beginning): A survey course introducing the elements for East & West Coast Swing and Lindy.

** **West Coast Swing** (Elemental Figures): David's creative magic for West Coast Swing! Prerequisites: basics

Non repeatable class designations: "Beg intermediate" is starting intermediate. Beg/intermediate is beginning & intermediate patterns, "A" is the first 6 weeks of a dance style, B is 2nd, etc.

Note: It is recommended you RETAKE a Beginning class at least THREE times before entering Intermediate, does not apply to "intro" classes or Level 1. If you advance too early, you miss fundamentals and you may hold back the other class members.

Repeatable class designations: "Level 2" follows Level 1 in pattern complexity and techniques, and so forth. You do not have to retake a level before preceding to the next level for Level classes.

Class Receipt

We are the only studio in San Diego that lets students repeat many classes for FREE! In order to continue doing this we have created the Class Receipt, which the student receives on the second meeting of class, after that ask your instructor. When the course ends ask the registrar for your pass. Lost Class Receipts can be replaced for \$1. **Bring the Class Receipt every night you are repeating a class!** This will make it possible for us to continue this system. It expedites the registration process. We feel it is important for the student to be able to repeat in order to learn but the administration is a lot of work and we need your help and cooperation so that we may continue to offer this service. Why we rotate partners!

Most social dance schools rotate students. Through years of experience I have noticed that this is what works best. It creates a positive atmosphere in the class. Students, whether in a couple or single, learn more effectively when they rotate partners. It minimizes students teaching/criticizing each other (couples are notorious for this). Criticism and amateurs trying to teach is detrimental to the learning process. In my 25 years of experience I have learned that the class runs more efficiently when all the students are rotating. I have been teaching these classes since 1983 with about 500 students in classes weekly now. We have always rotated partners and have had a lot of success using our system.

Alternatives to class instruction follow:

1. Private lesson with an instructor.
2. Semi-private/small group of your own with an instructor.
3. If you are dissatisfied after your first class for any reason, please call or email to request a partial refund of your money.
